

La Mirada NJB Residency Rules

In an effort to communicate the requirements placed on La Mirada by the City of La Mirada, we have provided the following information which explains the process in which our league has to operate under for Residency Rules. These rules also coincide with the requirements from NJB National Headquarters.

Regular League- La Mirada NJB must have 75% of their players live in the city of La Mirada. (We can accept 25% from other cities)

All-Stars- La Mirada All-Star teams will be comprised of players from the Winter League teams. (A player release form may be required for non-resident players).

All-Net Head Coaches- La Mirada All-Net head coaches must live in La Mirada and/or their child must attend a school in La Mirada in order to coach a La Mirada All-Net team. All-Net Coaches must be a member of the La Mirada NJB Board of Directors.

All-Net Players- All NJB players are welcome to try-out for an All-Net team. All Non-Resident players who want to play All-Net for La Mirada must get a release from the city NJB Chapter in which they live. A maximum of 2 Non-Resident players are allowed on each All-Net Team.
